

Public Speaker/Editor in Chief/SF Writer

Francesco Verso (Bologna, 1973) is one of the most relevant authors of contemporary Italian Science Fiction. He studied Environmental Economics in Amsterdam and graduated from the University of Roma Tre in 1999. After 8 years of work as an IT specialist in IBM and Lenovo, he decided to become a full-time writer of Science Fiction. Over the last 20 years, he has won many SF awards (3 Europe Award, 2 Urania Awards, 2 Italia Awards, 1 Galaxy Award and 1 Marco Polo Award for the promotion of Chinese SF) and for 12 years he's been the editor of the multicultural project called Future Fiction. His books include: *Antidoti umani*, *e-Doll*, *Livido*, *Bloodbusters*, *Evoluzione*, *I camminatori* (made of *The Pulldogs* and *No/Mad/Land*) and *Chimeriade*. His stories have been published in the USA, the UK, India, China, France, Brazil and Bulgaria. He's also a public speaker and a promoter of Science Fiction in Translation and Solarpunk to many SF Conventions around the world. Since 2014 he works as editor of *Future Fiction*, a multicultural project, publishing the best SF in translation from 14 languages and more than 40 countries with authors like Ian McDonald, Liu Cixin, Chen Qiufan, Olivier Paquet, Vandana Singh, Lavie Tidhar, and others. From 2019 he's the Honorary Director of the Fishing Fortress SF Academy of Chongqing where he has started a creative writing Science Fiction workshop.
